SILENCE SPEAKS is organised by HEROINES'WAVE, an international and independent collective of womxn who research and create about female intimacy through exhibitions, archives, podcasts and public talks.

In 2021, they are invited to Thailand to curate an exhibition about female psychology with artists from Thailand, Ukraine, Korea, Georgia, France, Germany and Singapore. During three evenings, they will welcome you in this old school fully transformed in an ENCLOSED GARDEN from Friday, 23 April to Sunday, 25 April.
